What warning did James give to those who make plans for the future?

What ways can "our" plans be impacted by life?

Does including God in our plans mean we will never experience difficulties or trials?

We tend to think of sin as what we do wrong, but is James implying in verse 17 that our thoughts can be sin, just as much as our actions?
